

Cookie Policy

Cookies are small text files which are stored on the browser or hard drive of your computer or mobile device when you visit a webpage or application.

The information in the cookie can be used to track your navigation habits within our website. Cookies do not carry any personally identifiable information and are only used to track the effectiveness of our website (for example by counting the number of visitors).

We use cookies to enhance your browsing experience by recognising when you visit us and any preference settings. Analysing how you use our website helps us improve your browsing experience and also troubleshoot any problems and monitor our own performance. AJIB Cyprus Branch's website only uses performance cookies by Google Analytics (<https://marketingplatform.google.com/about/analytics/>).

Most browsers accept cookies automatically, but you can alter the settings of your browser to erase cookies or prevent automatic acceptance if you prefer. Generally you have the option to see what cookies you have and delete them individually, block third party cookies or cookies from particular sites, accept all cookies, be notified when a cookie is issued or reject all cookies.
